

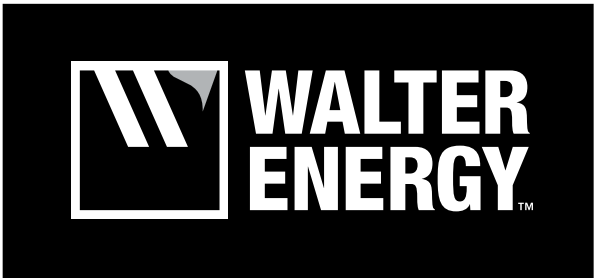


Walter Energy - Basic Logo Standards Guidelines

The Walter Energy logo should be reproduced in its preferred, full-color design whenever possible. This helps to build brand consistency. In situations where the logo cannot be reproduced accurately or when the surface or background on which the logo has been applied does not provide sufficient contrast, the one-color, or reversed-out versions may be used. The white sections of the “Block W,” as they appear here, should remain white in all appearances.

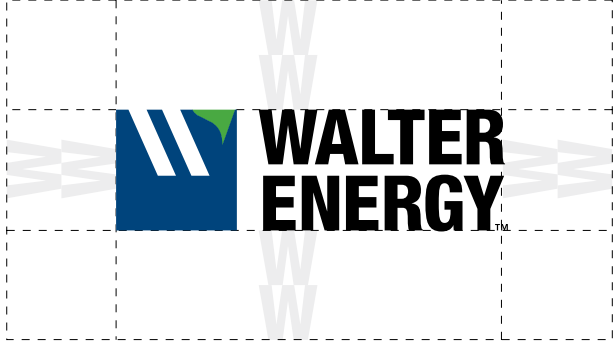
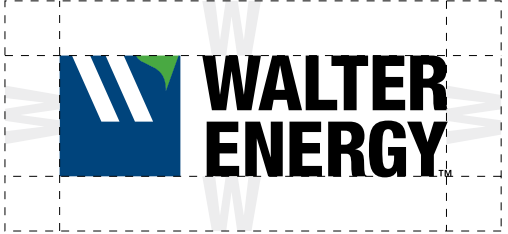
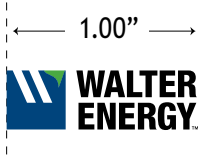





The elements of the logo, specifically the “Block W” and the word mark “Walter Energy,” should never be separated. The trademark tag “TM” should be used with the logo at all times.

Walter Energy - Basic Logo Standards Guidelines

<p>EXCLUSION ZONES</p> <p>The <i>preferred</i> clear space unit of measurement is determined by the height of the “W” in Walter <i>doubled</i>. This unit of clear space should be used on every side of the logo.</p> <p>The <i>minimum</i> clear space unit is determined by the height of one “W” in Walter. The minimum clear space should be only be used when the preferred clear space is not possible due to size constraint. This unit of clear space should be used on every side of the logo.</p> <p>These rules apply regardless of the logo’s size and exist to protect the brand integrity.</p>	<p>Preferred clear space:</p>  <p>Minimum clear space:</p> 			
<p>MINIMUM SIZE USAGE</p> <p>The logo should never be used smaller than 1.0” wide, with its width defined by the distance between the left side of the “Block W” and the right-side end of the logotype.</p>				
<p>COMMON MISTAKES</p> <p>Distorting the logo</p> <p>The logo should never be redrawn or recreated. The type, proportion and position of these elements are fixed. Do not modify them for any reason.</p>	 <p>Don't use on a similar color background</p> <p>Don't reverse on a light background</p> <p>Don't stretch the logo</p> <p>Don't rotate the logo</p> <p>Don't use the logo in outlined form</p> <p>Don't use with a custom logotype</p> <p>Don't use with a drop shadow</p> <p>Don't use in a subordinated position</p>			
 <p>Don't allow the background color to appear in the “shafts”.
